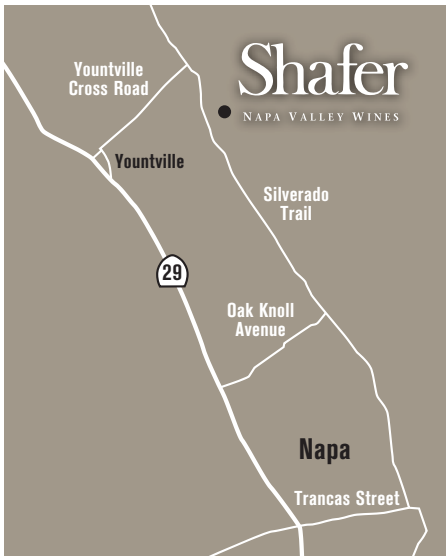




DIRECTIONS TO SHAFER VINEYARDS



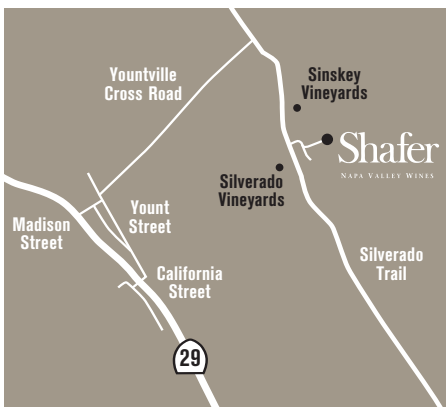
DIRECTIONS TO SHAFER

HEADING SOUTH ON SILVERADO TRAIL:

- We do not have a winery sign on the road, so be sure to look for the street address
- We are located 0.7 miles south of the Yountville Cross Road on Silverado Trail
- If you are heading south on Silverado Trail from the Yountville Cross Road, you'll pass Robert Sinskey winery on the left. You'll then round a big bend in the road, and then you'll need to take a left (east) when you approach the middle turn lane, at 6154 Silverado Trail
- Keep an eye out for a sign post with six addresses on it, one of the addresses is 6154
- There is a sign at the head of the road that reads, "Private Drive"
- Once you turn off the Silverado Trail the private drive curves around the base of a hill and splits. Go left and you'll see that Shafer entrance. The winery is located at the end of that driveway

HEADING NORTH ON SILVERADO TRAIL:

- We do not have a winery sign on the road, so be sure to look for the street address
- If heading north on Silverado Trail, we are about 7 miles north of Trancas St (in Napa). Once you pass Silverado Vineyards (on your left) you'll need to take the very next right turn at 6154 Silverado Trail
- Keep an eye out for a sign post with six addresses on it, one of the addresses is 6154
- There is a sign at the head of the road that reads, "Private Drive"
- Once you turn off the Silverado Trail the private drive curves around the base of a hill and splits. Go left and you'll see that Shafer entrance. The winery is located at the end of that driveway



FROM HIGHWAY 29 AT YOUNTVILLE:

- From Hwy 29 take the Madison Street exit into Yountville. At the second stop sign take a left on Yount Street, then an immediate right onto Yountville Cross Road. You'll go 1.8 miles to Silverado Trail
- Take a right on Silverado Trail for 0.7 miles. (You'll pass Robert Sinskey winery on the left. You'll then round a big bend in the road, and will need to use the turn lane in the center of the road to make a left-hand (east) turn at 6154 Silverado Trail
- There is a sign at the head of the road that reads, "Private Drive"
- Once you turn off the Silverado Trail the private drive curves around the base of a hill and splits. Go left and you'll see that Shafer entrance. The winery is located at the end of that driveway
